- Blue Cross NC commits \$1,000,000 for the Division of Nursing

 - Goal is to serve 40 incoming juniors and seniors over three years
 - Non-endowed fund

 - Title III match \$50,000

Stewardship Highlights Q4

- Continued implementation of the donor acknowledgement tier system. Approximately 60 first-time alumni donors received letters from the Director of Alumni Engagement during the first quarter.
- The 2018 Scholarship Luncheon was held April 12, 2018. Over 150 individuals attended this event.
- The Searchable Scholarship Database is now live. The current database lists all of the endowed scholarships currently offered. The non-endowed scholarships will be added gradually with a targeted completion date of June 30, 2018.
