Atkins-Dillard-McCray Music Scholarship

This scholarship was established by First Baptist Church (East) to aid academically promising and financially deserving students to enter Winston-Salem State University and complete their undergraduate education in music. Where it is feasible, the student must meet guidelines for federal financial aid. The student should be an entering freshman who has no less than a 3.00 cumulative GPA from high school and an 800 composite SAT score or an equivalent ACT. In addition, the student may be a rising sophomore with a 3.00 or above cumulative GPA at Winston-Salem State University. This scholarship is not renewable, and is to be awarded during commencement week.

Criteria for applicants:

- student must be in good academic standing with the University and the Music Department
- demonstrate commitment to a career in music
- student must write a one-page essay expressing goals as a music major
- student must submit one letter of recommendation from applied instructor
- student must submit an unofficial university transcript
- student must submit a copy of SAT/ACT scores
- student must submit a completed James A. Dillard & Martha S. Atkins Scholarship Application
