

# APTA Clinical Performance Instrument (CPI) 3.0

- CI's, if you need a new CPI account, you may use either your professional or personal email address. Your school email address will not work if you have an old CPI student account. Please send your preferred email address Bre'onca Wall at wallb@wssu.edu. She will set up your new CI account in CPI.
- CI's, be sure to let your student know the email address you used for CPI training.







- There will be a Significant Concerns Checkbox and Narrative Comment section at the end of each assessment where a CI can indicate if there are any safety concerns with the student.
- A CI or SCCE should still contact the DCE if there are safety concerns with the student.
